## The Book of Deuteronomy

The final book of the Pentateuch is Deuteronomy, which is written as the last speech and warning by Moses to the people on how to live in the land they are about to conquer. Since it was composed in the seventh century as a kind of commentary on the meaning of the Pentateuch and as a summary of its message, we shall treat it below in Chapter 17. Looking back from the troubled times of the last kings of Judah, it offered hope to a discouraged seventh century Israel, a new chance to obey the covenant and a lesson that God's punishment was not final. For these reasons, it stresses the divine word that never fails. It stands apart from the story structure of Genesis through Numbers in the form of a warning speech. It emphasizes how God tested Israel in the early days of its existence, yet did not destroy the people no matter how often they failed. The real meaning of the years in the desert can be found in the lesson God himself had taught there: "A person does not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of Yahweh" (Dt 8:2-3).
